## Recruits were pursued through the following career and internship fairs:

KSCE hosted a virtual job fair on Tuesday March 22, 2022. Job fair was advertised on air as well as social media platforms.

#### **Other Outreach Efforts:**

KSCE has partnered with the members of the University of Texas at El Paso to recruit students of the university to intern at the station and become involved in the station and learn broadcasting skills.

KSCE offers tours to students and organizations that are interested in broadcasting. 42 attendees came to the tours during this period.

KSCE has in-house training available for Master Control Operators who would like to gain knowledge and skills in other areas, including editing and production, in order to move up in the broadcast industry.
